Welcome to Wendover and its beautiful surrounding countryside at the foot of the Chiltern hills.

Wendover is a market town and the High Street with its historic, cobbled Manor Waste is the heart of the village. Welcoming restaurants and pubs are interspersed with shops offering everything from food to antiques, clothes to newspapers and hats to hardware.

Take a moment to enjoy the services of beauticians, hairdressers or even buy a house!

The oldest building in Wendover is St Mary's church which has 12th century origins. Its oldest features however date from the late 13th century. Of particular interest are the early 14th century nave capitals carved with foliage entwined with human heads and beasts.

There are many lovely walks through the Chilterns - information and maps are available from the Tourist Information Office in The Clock Tower.

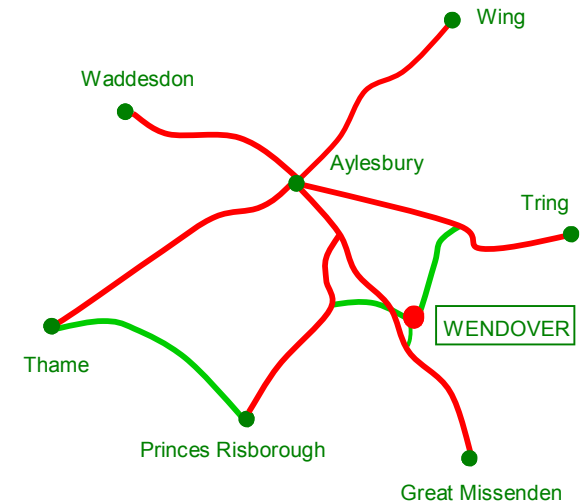


## THE MARKET STALLS
