

## Wendover Parish Council

### Regulations for Hampden Pond

The following are **prohibited** on the Council's property:-

1. Any action which may cause pollution or other contamination of the pond
2. Interference with the drains or apparatus of any kind
3. Cutting down or injuring in any way trees, plants, hedges or the digging or removal of soil
4. Any interference with the wildlife
5. Bathing or swimming
6. Standing in the waters for any purpose
7. The staking out or reserving in any way of places for bank fishing
8. Angling competitions, unless by prior arrangement
9. The lighting of any fires
10. Boats

### General Rules

1. Only two rods may be assembled and used at any one time
2. A National Rivers Authority licence must be obtained in addition to a permit from the Parish Council
3. Any infringement of the Environmental Agency rules or bylaws will be deemed to be an infringement of Council rules and will be liable to disciplinary action
4. Litter and discarded fishing tackle, especially lengths of nylon, must not be left on the bank
5. Permits are not transferable
6. No spinning is permitted
7. Barbless or de-barbed hooks only to be used
8. No keep nets allowed
9. Single hooks only to be used - maximum size 10
10. Dogs must be kept on leads within the fenced area of the pond
11. Anglers use the water entirely at their own risk
12. Children below the age of 12 must be accompanied by an adult
13. The Council reserves the right to prohibit fishing and to alter or vary these rules at any time in the general interest of fishing or safety
14. All fish must be returned to the water
15. Fishing is permitted between sunrise and sunset only. (No night fishing)
16. Fishing will be prohibited between 14 March and 1 May of each year
