

Local Authorities (Members Allowances) (England) Regulations 2003

1. Pursuant to the above Regulations, the Aylesbury Vale Parish Remuneration Panel reported on 14 December 2006 and has made recommendations as to Members' Allowances payable to Parish Councillors. The Parish Council has received these recommendations.

2. The main recommendations of the Independent Remuneration Panel are as follows:-
 1. Councillors' basic allowances should not exceed £1 per member of the electorate (Wendover's electorate = 5475, at 14 October 2008)
 2. Travel at HM Revenue and Customs mileage rate of 40p per for cars, for councillors on approved duties only.

3. At its meeting on 1 December 2008, the Parish Council resolved that:-
 1. Members' Basic Allowance would be paid at 1 May 2009
 2. The "historic" Chairman's allowance payable under the Local Government Act 1972 would continue to be paid; and
 3. It would pay Travel and Subsistence Allowance at the rates recommended by the Independent Remuneration Panel
